POSITION INFORMATION

- Baker Technical Institute is currently seeking a candidate for a part-time Truck Driving School Instructor based out of the Baker City campus.

PROFESSIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- Hold a current Class A CDL.
- 3 years' experience driving a Commercial Motor Vehicle requiring a Class A CDL.
- Recent truck driving experience to include tractor-trailer over the road driving or related construction type driving.
- A Class A CDL driving record in good standing as determined by the Department of Motor Vehicles and Baker Technical Institute.
- Experience operating heavy equipment; dozers, graders, excavators, wheel loaders, and any other related equipment a plus.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

- Demonstrated knowledge of the principles and practices of safe truck driving and all the laws and regulations covering tractor-trailer interstate operations. Driving instructors must also be capable of demonstrating the BTI curriculum subject matter.
- Able to use a wide variety of teaching methods to promote learning.
- Strictly follow all State and Federal guidelines in the classroom, on the road, and at the driving range.
- Intermediate knowledge of general maintenance and OSHA safety requirements around trucks, equipment, and job sites.
- Knowledgeable and experienced with a variety of tractors and trailers as well as diverse driving conditions.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills.
- Strong organizational skills and a highly motivated individual.
- Ability to engage the student in decision-making, reasoning, and problem-solving.
- Shall have exhibited an earnest desire to work with students in order to provide them the opportunity to develop to their fullest potential.
- Intermediate knowledge of heavy equipment operation preferred.
- Experience on construction sites is a plus
- Able to perform normal duties with minimal supervision.

MAJOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Instruct Truck Driving School operation, safety and basic maintenance to students. Instruction will include classroom coursework, the use of simulators in a mobile training environment, and practical operating training on driving ranges, and over the road.
- Truck driving instruction includes basic skills, coordination, maneuvers and road training on public streets, roads and highways. Prepare students with the skills necessary to obtain a Commercial Driver's License.
- Establishes the concern for the safety and general welfare of the student.
- Works collaboratively with BTI management to improve the overall program and the student experience.
- Support an environment where students can gain self-esteem and develop a positive self-image.
- Maintains a positive attitude toward performing job duties and works well with other staff members.
- Relies on extensive experience and judgment to plan and accomplish goals.
- Performs a variety of complex tasks with minimal supervision. Ability to maintain and perform minor repairs on trucks and equipment.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Must be physically mobile enough to work in a classroom and/or outdoor environment with trucks/equipment and students daily. Position requires some travel and potentially work during evenings and weekends.

POLICY

- Copy of the Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD 214 or 215) OR proof of receiving a non-service connected pension from the US Department of Veteran's Affairs.
